- b) H. Wieniawski Collection Op. 10 (No. 2-8)
- c) K. Lipiński Op. 29 No 1 or 3
- d) N. Paganini Caprice Op. 1

STAGE 2

- 1. The first part chosen Sonata or Sonatina of the following composers:
 - a) W. A. Mozart
 - b) L.van Beethoven
 - c) F. Schubert
- 2. Any piece for volin solo or with piano accompaniament. Duration not longer than 15 minutes.

STAGE 3

1. Any violin concerto composed after the end of the baroque era.

STAGE 1
